ACCUPLACER TESTING AT LEEWARD WAI'ANA

GENERAL INFO

- There are 2 sections on the test:
WRITING (you will write an essay), & **MATH** (min. of 20 multiple choice questions).
- There is no time limit, but each test section usually takes about 1 hour to complete.
- Your scores will print up right after you finish.
- Scores are valid for 2 years. The first test is free.
 If you would like to retest within those 2 years, there is a \$25 fee, payable by check or money order to *Leeward Community College*.

REMEMBER TO BRING

- Picture ID (e.g., a driver's license, state ID, military ID, or school ID)
- A jacket, as the building is very cold.

Cellular phones & other electronics are not allowed in the testing room.

Any that you have with you must be left in the locked cabinet outside the testing room.
